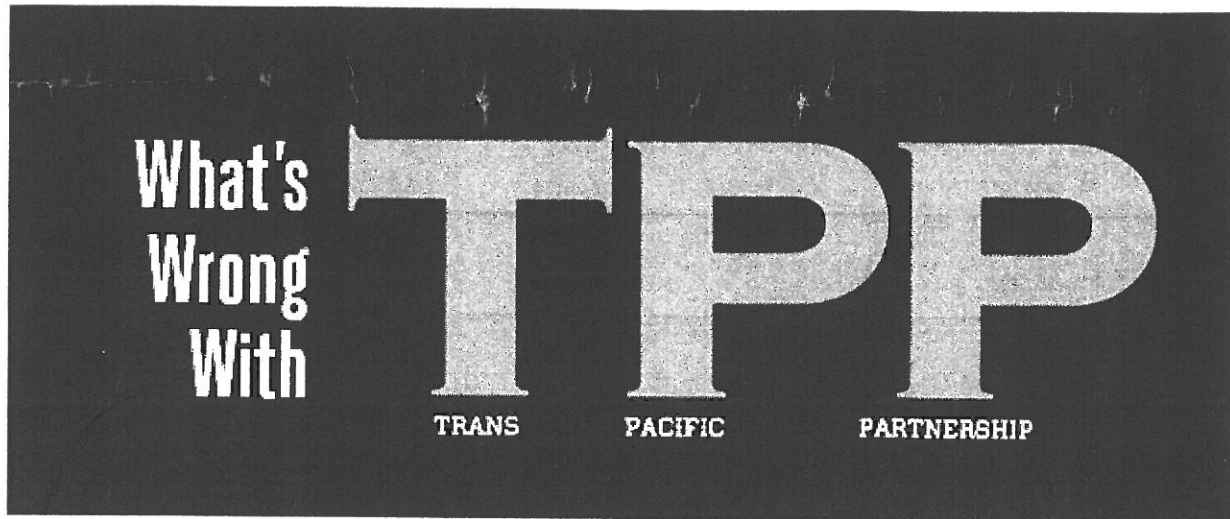


People's Town Hall on the Trans Pacific Partnership – Why We Should Care

The panel will discuss the impact of the TPP on local jobs, our environment, food safety, healthcare and democracy.
